







25 OER virtual reality scenarios are being created. Over 100 OER simulation videos have been uploaded to the Open RN YouTube channel.



Projected allitual maximum cost savings for Nursing students across the state if all 16 WTGS colleges adapt the five OER textbooks as the required textbook for the course.






